12 Stepping a Problem

This writing exercise is an approach, using the 12 Steps of OA, to deal with life's challenges without turning to food.

- 2) Do I believe that a power greater than myself can restore me to sanity? YES or NO If NO, explain why not. What would recovery look like in relation to this problem?
- 3) Have I made a decision to turn _____ over to the care of God/Higher Power? YES or NO If NO, explain why not.
- 4) Make a searching and fearless moral inventory of myself. List any fears, resentments, harms. What is my part in this?
- 5) Am I willing to admit to God/Higher Power, myself, and another person the exact nature of the wrongs that contributed to this situation? If YES, continue to #6. If NO, return to #1.
- 6) Am I entirely ready to have God/Higher Power remove these defects of character? YES or NO If no, explain why not.
- 7) Have I humbly asked God/Higher Power to remove my shortcomings? YES or NO (Refer to fears, resentments, harms in number four above.)
- 8) Make a list of all persons I have harmed because of this. (Include yourself.) How have they been harmed? Am I willing to make amends to them all?
- 9) How and when will I make amends?
- 10) Continue to take a personal inventory. What specific actions can I take today?
- 11) What specific actions can I take today to establish, re-establish, or improve conscious contact with God/Higher Power?
- 12) What spiritual awakening/new insight have I had as the result of working these Steps on this specific problem?



RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR OA SFVI BOARD POSITIONS

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS (exceptions are noted below):

- One (1) year of continuous abstinence
- Six (6) months of service above the meeting level
- Regular attendee of an active OA group for a period of one (1) year
- Attends all Board and Delegates meetings

CHAIR: (1 Year Commitment)

- Presides at all regular and special meetings of the OASFVI
- Establishes the agenda for all OASFVI board and delegates meetings
- Serves as an ex-officio member to all committees, as needed
- Serves as the liaison to OASFVI employee(s), and office operations
- May cast the deciding vote to make or break a tie
- Co-signer of all OASFVI bank accounts
- · Requires 3 years of continuous abstinence

TREASURER: (1 Year Commitment)

- Monitors checking and savings accounts via online banking and orders disbursements of OASFVI funds
- Submits financial reports each month at the OASFVI meetings
- · Serves as chairperson of the budget committee
- Is a co-signer of all OASFVI bank accounts
- Requires 3 years of continuous abstinence

VICE CHAIR: (1 Year Commitment)

- Serves in the absence of the chairperson
- Assists the chairperson whenever needed, including taking on ad hoc projects
- Shall update speaker/leader lists at least annually
- May be a co-signer of all OASFVI bank accounts

SECRETARY: (1 Year Commitment)

- Keeps minutes of all OASFVI board and delegates meetings
- Prepares minutes for sending to attending IRs and board members
- · Updates the policy and procedures manual as changes occur

NEWSLETTER EDITOR: (1 Year Commitment)

- Compiles information monthly for the OASFVI 5TH Tradition newsletter
- Distributes digital newsletters through Delegate Coordinator
- Coordinates printing of the newsletter and delivery to the OA office (if we return to printed copies)

SPECIAL EVENTS AND FUNDRAISING (1 Year Commitment)

- Coordinates all approved fundraising activities for the Intergroup
- Coordinates with Office Manager as treasurer for Special Events and Fundraising events
- Plans and coordinates special events and fund-raising activities for the fellowship

TWELFTH STEP WITHIN/WORKSHOPS: (1 Year Commitment)

- · Coordinates all approved Workshops and Twelfth Step Within activities
- Responds to all Workshops and Twelfth Step Within inquiries

DIGITAL RESOURCES / Web technician: (1 Year Commitment)

- Support, update, and maintain the OASFVI website and systems
- Support as needed virtual presentation of meetings, workshops, marathons, etc.
- Creation and posting of virtual event flyers and announcements
- · Posts recordings as podcasts on the Intergroup's website
- Maintains blog to publish and share information posts

PUBLIC OUTREACH: (1 Year Commitment)

- Responds to all initial requests for public information whether individual or institutional and delegate any follow-up to the appropriate committee or person
- Responds to requests for information from public media
- Coordinates all Hospitals & Institutions (H&I) activities
- Responds to requests for speakers/panels from/ medical community, hospitals, schools, and other institutions



HANDLING ZOOM BOMBERS

Before the meeting:

- Assign one or two CO-HOSTs to help with security
- Consider enabling the WAITING ROOM so participants can't get into the meeting until the hosts let them in
- Make sure only hosts can screenshare under "Security" tab
- Ask meeting participants to (initially) turn on their cameras

During the meeting:

If Zoom bombers get into your meeting, the hosts can:

- 1. Click MUTE ALL at the bottom of the "Participants" panel
- 2. DISABLE CHAT under "Security" tab on the bottom of the screen
- 3. If the waiting room isn't on, temporarily **LOCK the meeting,** under "Security", so that no new bombers can get in
- **4. REMOVE** all bombers from the "Participants" panel, click on participant's name and select "Remove" (can also click on their Zoom box and select "Remove")
- 5. Enable the WAITING ROOM and unlock the meeting under "Security"

NOTE: You must be the Host or Co-Host to access these controls.

DO YOU NEED HELP with ZOOM HOSTING or PROTECTING YOUR MEETING from ZOOM BOMBERS?

The OA San Diego Intergroup offers several different **Zoom Hosting Classes** to teach the skills you need to volunteer for service positions.
